William Boeing

Aviation Pioneer

BORN October 1st, 1881

DIED 1956 (aged 74)

NATIONALITY American

William Boeing was an aviation pioneer who founded The Boeing Company in 1916. He was born in Michigan of immigrant parents; his mother from Austria and his father from Germany.

In 1909, he saw a manned flying machine for the first time and became fascinated. He took flying lessons and purchased his own plane. When the plane was damaged, he was told that replacement parts would not be available for months. Boeing told his friend, "We could build a better plane ourselves and build it faster." They soon built and flew the B & W Seaplane, an amphibian biplane that had outstanding performance.

When America entered the First World War, Boeing obtained orders from the US Navy for 50 planes. At the end of the war, Boeing concentrated on commercial aircraft to service airmail contracts.

Boeing was married and had 1 son.

Mahatma Gandhi

Independence Activist & Spiritual Leader

BORN October 2nd, 1869

DIED 1948 (aged 78)

NATIONALITY Indian

Mahatma Gandhi employed nonviolent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India's independence from British rule and in turn inspired movements for civil rights and freedom across the world.

Gandhi trained in law before moving to South Africa where he lived for 21 years. In 1915, aged 45, he returned to India and led nationwide campaigns for easing poverty, expanding women's rights, ending untouchability, and above all for achieving self-rule.

In 1947, Britain granted India independence, portioning it into two dominions, the Hindu-majority India and the Muslim-majority Pakistan. Gandhi was opposed to the partition, working vigorously to show that Muslims and Hindus could live together peacefully.

Aged 78, Gandhi was killed by a Hindu Brahmin opposed to his support for Muslims and the untouchables. He was married with 4 children.

Chubby Checker

Singer-Songwriter

BORN October 3rd, 1941

NATIONALITY American

Chubby Checker (born Ernest Evans) is widely known for popularizing many dance styles including *The Twist* dance style with his 1960 hit cover of the song "The Twist", and *The Pony* dance style with his 1961 cover of the song "Pony Time".

His best-known song is the hit "Let's Twist Again", released in 1961. He also popularized the song "Limbo Rock" in 1962, originally an instrumental hit to which he added lyrics, and its trademark *Limbo* dance. He also popularized other dance styles such as *The Fly*.

In September 2008, "The Twist" topped Billboard's list of the most popular singles to have appeared in the Hot 100 since its debut in 1958.

He is married and has 4 children.

Susan Sarandon

Actress

BORN October 4th, 1946

NATIONALITY American

Susan Sarandon was born in Queens in New York City, the eldest of nine children.

She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in drama before beginning her acting career in the film *Joe* (1970) and the soap opera *A World Apart* (1970–1971). In 1975 she starred as Janet Weiss in the musical comedy horror film *The Rocky Horror Picture Show*.

Sarandon was nominated for the Academy Award for Best Actress for *Atlantic City* (1980), *Thelma & Louise* (1991), *Lorenzo's Oil* (1992), and *The Client* (1994), before winning for *Dead Man Walking* (1995).

Her other films include *Pretty Baby* (1978), *The Hunger* (1983), *The Witches of Eastwick* (1987) and *Little Women* (1994).

Sarandon is also known for her social and political activism and was appointed a UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador in 1999.

She has been married once and has 3 children.

Imran Khan

22nd Prime Minister of Pakistan

BORN October 5th, 1952

NATIONALITY Pakistani

Imran Khan is the 22nd Prime Minister of Pakistan. Before entering politics, Khan was an international cricketer and captain of the Pakistan national cricket team.

Khan began his international cricket career at age 18, in a 1971 Test series against England. After graduating from Oxford, Khan joined Pakistan's national cricket team in 1976, and played until 1992. Khan also served as the team's captain intermittently throughout 1982–1992. He, notably, led Pakistan to victory at the 1992 Cricket World Cup, Pakistan's first and only victory in that competition. Khan is considered one of cricket's greatest ever all-rounders.

Khan was elected as Prime Minister in 2018. He pledged to put the poor and commoners of the country first and to ensure that policies were geared towards elevating the standards of living of the lesser fortunate.

Khan remains a popular political figure and is the author of *Pakistan: A Personal History*.
