Scottish beer 'Snake Venom' is the strongest beer in the world, having 67% of alcohol, instead of the 5% of other beers.

In English pubs, ale is ordered by pints and quart... So when customers got unruly, the bartender would yell: "Mind your pints and quarts, and settle down ". That's where the phrase 'mind your P's and Q's' comes from.

While drinking a beer, tilt the glass and observe if the foam adheres to the side. If it does, it is considered good quality beer by many people.

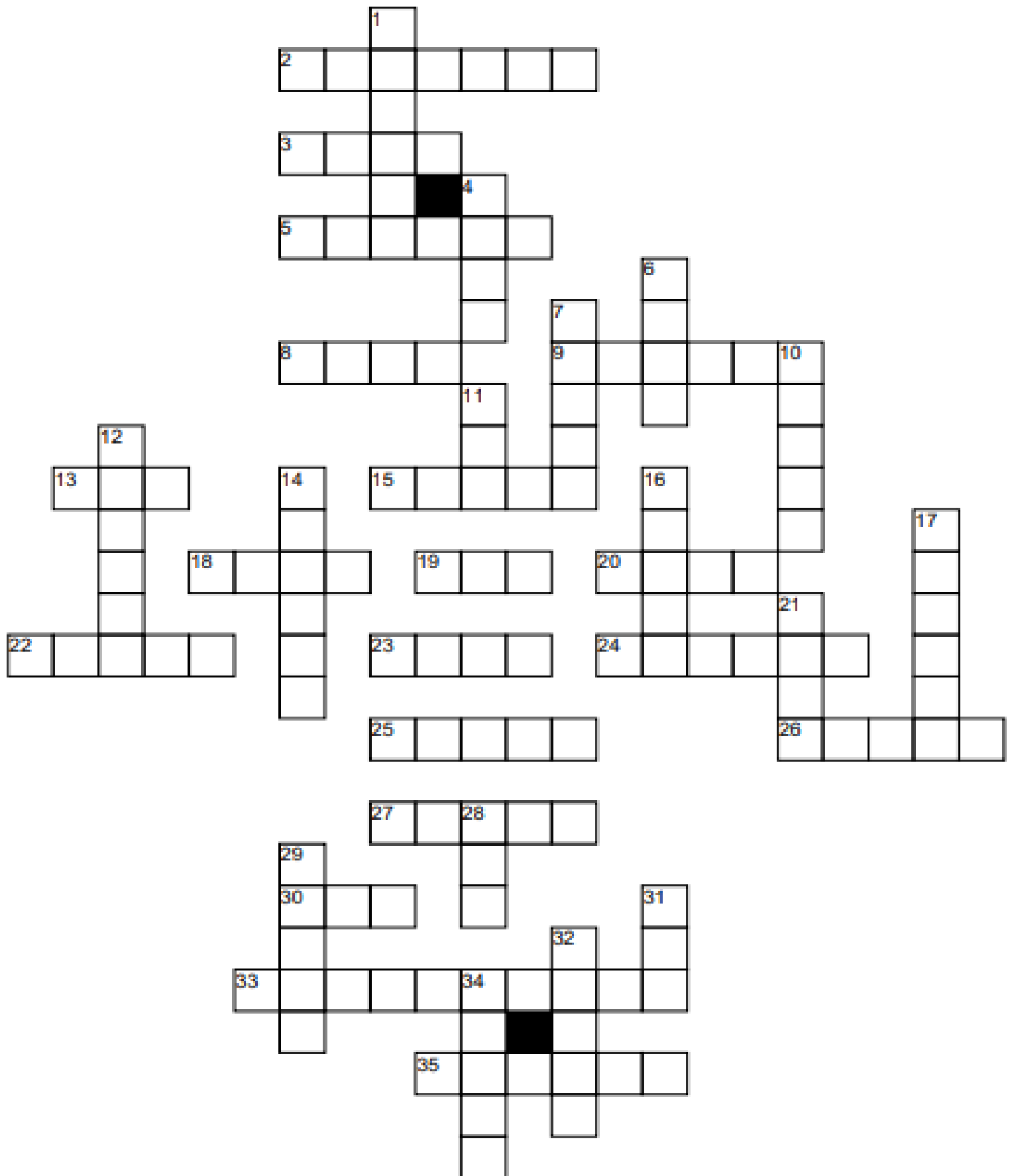

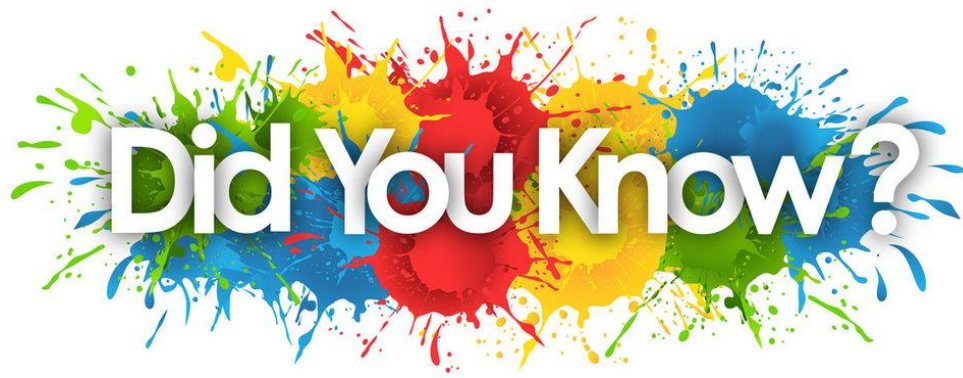
The CEO of Budweiser asked for a Budweiser, the one from Heineken's asked for a Heineken and the one from Foster's asked for a Foster.

- The oldest continuously operating brewery in the world is Weihenstephan in the state of Bavaria – Germany. It has been operating since 1040!
- Beer is mentioned in the first set of laws ever written: The Code of Hammurabi in 1772 BCE. King Hammurabi of Babylonian decreed that his subjects would have a daily ration of beer, according to their social status! The Babylonians took their beer making so seriously that if you made a bad batch your punishment was to drown in it!
- China is the fastest growing beer market in the world.
- 'Six Pack' beer cans were first produced in 1935.
- **'ZYTHOLOGY'** is the study of beer and beer making.
- Budweiser has been the world's best-selling beer since 1957, and is distributed in more than 70 countries.
- 'Billy Beer' is a beer named after US President Jimmy Carter's brother: William Alton Carter III. It was produced by Falls City Brewing Company of Louisville, Kentucky.
- Munich in Germany is a city of 1.2 million people and every year in October it receives 6 million visitors for the 18 day 'Oktoberfest' celebrations.
- It has been said that the Puritans (a group of English Reformed Protestants) carried more beer than water on board the Mayflower ship!
- The Encyclopaedia Britannica was once banned in Texas because it gave a recipe for home-made beer!
- Before thermometers, beer fermentation was tested by the brewer placing his thumb in the brewing liquid. If the thumb had to be removed because of heat, the brewer had to wait for it to cool further before adding the yeast.
- The word 'Bridal' comes from 19 century Englishmen, who took out their mates for a final 'Bride Ale' the day before their wedding.
- Us President Franklin Delano Roosevelt was elected in 1932 partly because he promised to end the Prohibition.

Beer Hummus Recipe



Celebrate International Beer Day with Beer Hummus and crackers!

Ingredients:

2 cans of garbanzo beans (chickpeas)

1 TB spoon of lemon juice

1 TB olive oil

3 cloves of garlic minced or grated

2 TB Tahini (sesame seeds paste)

¼ cup beer (more if needed)

1 tea spoon of coriander powder

1/2 teaspoon of cumin powder

½ tea spoon salt

Method:

Place all ingredients in a food processor or blender and blend until smooth.

Add a little more beer if the consistency is too thick.

Serve with pita bread cut into small pieces or with raw vegetables and a glass of beer of course!

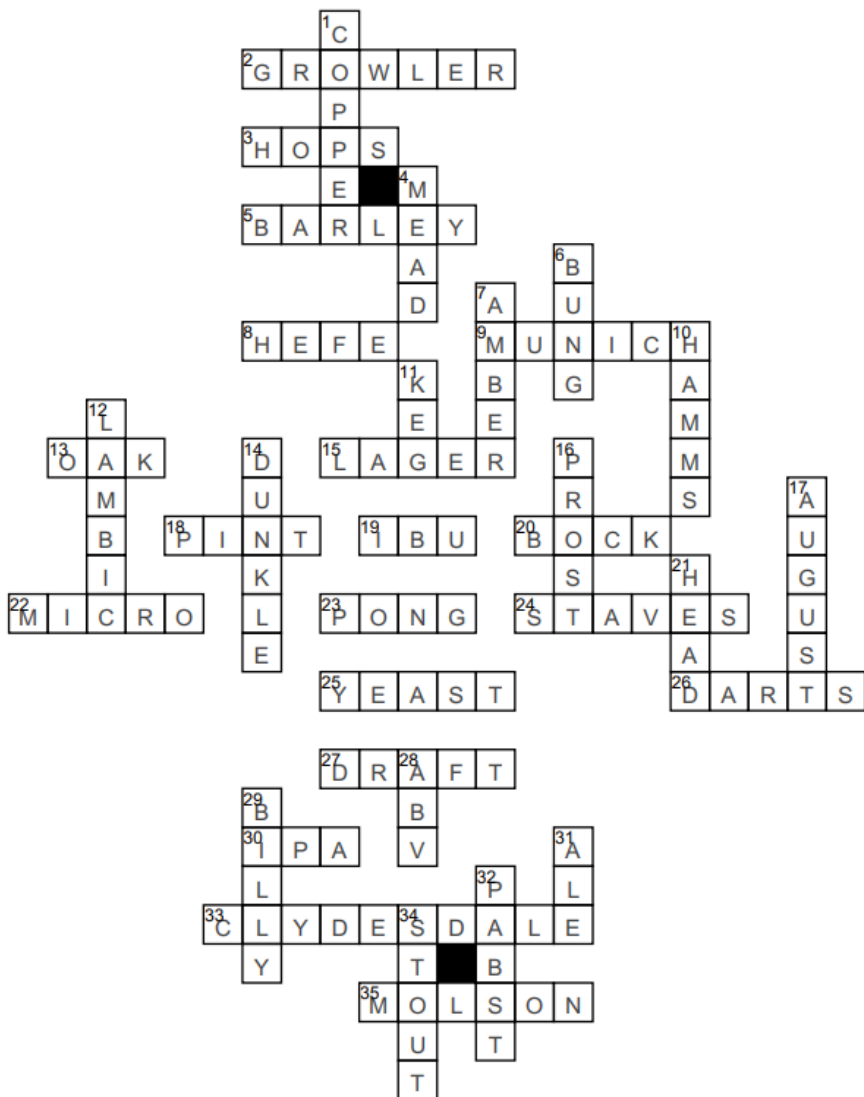
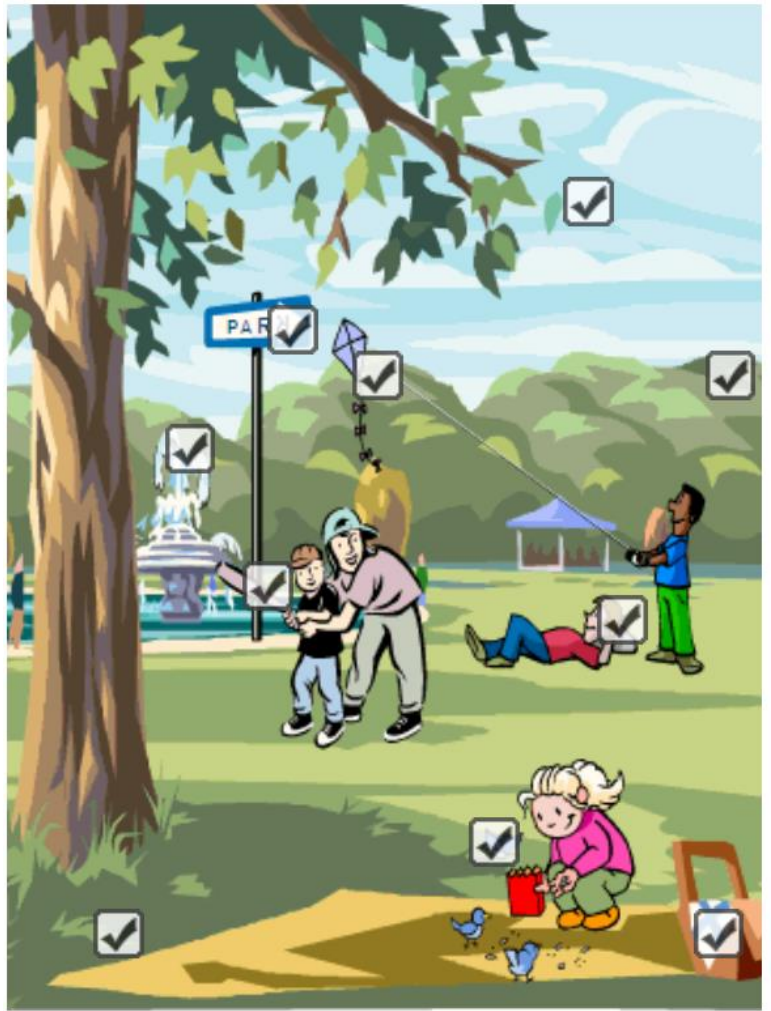
